

All Age Divisions

15-18 Age Division is broken down into two categories

15-16 Intermediate (both genders)

17-18 Young Men/Women

19-29 Open Division

30-39 Sub-Masters

40+ Masters

All Sub-Master Athletes compete in five-year age divisions

15-18 Age Division Race Walk Events*

**Note: the 1600m and 3200m race walk will alternate from week to week. A 22 minute time limit will be placed on all race walk events. For those athletes who are unable to finish the event with the allotted time, it is suggested that they compete only in the 1600m race walk to develop strength and proper walking technique.*

Membership

Membership in USATF is required for all Wednesday evening meets as well as for competition in the Maine USATF Outdoor Championship to be held July 18, 2010. This meet is for Open, Sub-Master, and Master athletes only. All **athletes much have a valid 2011 USATF membership number.**

MEUSATF offers a **discount to those athletes not turning 19 during the 2011. calendar year.** Membership for these individuals is **\$15.** To receive this membership, the USATF Membership Application **must be sent to: MEUSATF, 417 Hartland Road, Canaan, ME 04924** along with payment. Or, membership may be purchased during any of the outdoor series meets.

2011 Summer Track and Field

Location: All meets except the Championship will be held at Lewiston High School, Franklin Pastures Athletic Complex in Lewiston, Maine (using Map Quest or Google Maps, the school's address is 156 East Avenue, Lewiston, Maine).

Directions: from I-95 take Exit #80, then at Tim Horton's turn right onto East Street; the high school is located on the left in less than one mile after the turn.

Meet start times: Wednesdays at 5:30 pm
Championship meet at Cony on Sunday, July 18 at 10:30 am

General Information: These meets are for Open, Sub-master and Master athletes with an additional competition division of 15-18 year-olds for the high school aged athlete.

There is no limit placed on the number of events in which Open, Sub-Master and Master athletes may enter. **The 15-18 athletes may enter only four events (including the relay).**

All events with at least three competitors will be contested. **All running events are timed finals.** Events may be combined for all ages divisions and genders, but awards are separate per age division and gender.

These meets follow all USA Track and Field Rules of Competition; all meets are sanctioned through Maine USATF.

First four events are included in the entry fee; any event entered beyond four is an **additional \$3/event.**
