The Race Route

Nuts and Bolts

1. Parking for the race, check in & registration (starting at 9:00), and rest rooms, are all at the Penobscot Community School.
2. Both races, the One Mile Fun Run and the 5k start at the Historical Society.
3. The 5k route goes from the Historical Society on Rte 199, to the intersection of 175. Turn left and follow 175 to the Chocolate Church. Loop at the Church and return to finish behind the School.
4. The One Mile Fun Run starts at the Historical Society, turns at the Northern Bay Residential Living Center and finishes behind the School.
5. There is medical assistance available at the Penobscot Fire Dept.
6. An awards ceremony will be held immediately after the race in the school gym.
7. A chicken BBQ at the Fire Dept. will follow the awards ceremony.

2015 marks the Third Annual ChrisK 5K. To date over \$12,000 has been raised for PCS in memory of Christine Kilpeck.
