

**SUB 5 TRACK CLUB
HIGH SCHOOL RUNNING CAMP SCHOLARSHIP**

The Sub 5 Track Club, founded in 1982 in the Bangor-Brewer area, is one of the largest and most active running clubs in the State of Maine. One of the club's primary goals is to promote and encourage long distance running and track and field as a competitive sport and as a means of life-long enjoyment. To further this goal, we have established the Sub 5 High School Running Camp Scholarship. It is our hope that this scholarship will provide high school athletes with the opportunity to improve their athletic skills and that it will be a positive and enjoyable experience. The requirements for the scholarship are as follows:

1. The athlete must have been a ninth, tenth, or eleventh grade student during the 2022-23 school year at a high school that is a member of the Penobscot Valley Conference.
2. The athlete must have competed in at least one season of cross country, indoor track, or outdoor track for their school during the 2022-23 school year.

Recipients will receive a tuition scholarship up to \$750 for a summer camp of their choice. We encourage recipients to choose an in-state camp, but out-of-state camps will be funded as well. Transportation costs are the responsibility of the athlete and their family.
