## Sub5 Race Series Rules *Rules subject to change should schedule change

*You must complete 5 series races to be eligible for an award.
*The age category of each runner is determined by their age at the first series race they enter for the calendar year.
*The top 10 runners in each age group receive points for each series race they complete. ( 1 st = 10 points, $2 \mathrm{nd}=9$ points, etc.)
*Awards are based on the runner's total points from their 5 best series performances.
*Awards are presented to the male and female with the highest point total overall, regardless of age category. These 2 runners are not eligible for an age group award.
*Awards are presented to the top 3 runners in the following age groups: $0-12,13-18,19-29,30-39,40-49,50-59,60-64$, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79 \& 80+.
*In the event of a tie, each runner's next best race performance (6th, 7 th, etc.) is considered until the tie is broken and a winner is determined. If for example, one runner has completed 5 races and the other tied runner 6 , then the runner with more races wins. If the winner cannot be determined, the runners may share the award as follows: Tie for 1 st and 2 nd place award is combined and divided evenly. Tie for 2nd and 3rd place award is combined and divided evenly. Tie for 3rd each runner receives a full award.
Membership to the Sub5 Track Club is not required to qualify for the race standings. However, membership fees help pay for series prizes, and support of the club. Membership registration is available online at: https://runsignup.com/sub5
